- 1) Paula reported we have approximately \$4,900 in the treasury.
- 2) Paula Kosiorek and Dave Malta will be going to the CPAC in Albany on Sun. Jan. 29<sup>th</sup> & Mon. Jan. 30<sup>th</sup>. They will give us a report at the next Executive Committee meeting.
- 3) We do not have the redistricting lines for Congress, State Senate and the State Assembly. The other seats that will be up this year with their incumbent or candidates are: President and Vice President- Obama/Biden, US Senate- Gillibrand, Supreme Court (2 seats)- Gail Donofrio and David Michael Barry, County Clerk- Cheryl Dinolfo, City Court- Yacknin, Brighton Justice- Falk, East Rochester Justice- Odorisi, Mendon Council- Karla Boyce replacement and Rush Justice- Kirch.
- 4) Election 2011 was a good year for the Conservative Party. We were the “Margin of Victory” in many races. We endorsed 114 candidates with 102 winners. The Conservative Party received almost 16,000 votes for our Supreme

Court candidate and we only have 7,400 enrolled Conservatives. Obtaining Row C back has been electorally beneficial.

5) The 50<sup>th</sup> annual Monroe County Conservative dinner is Friday,

May 18, 2012 at the Rochester Convention Center. There is no key note speaker yet. Dave Malta will try to get a “prestigious” key note speaker. The Executive Committee voted unanimously to award the “Roger J. Robach Conservative of the year award” to State Chairman, Mike Long.

6) The Republican race for President was briefly discussed. Obama is destroying our Country. Therefore, it is essential we endorse the most electable Conservative candidate. Regarding the Election 2012, Jim Alesi is disliked (the lawsuit, etc.) by almost all the Republicans. The Republican nominee in the 55<sup>th</sup> Senate District this year will probably be Mike Barker, Debbie Drawe, Karla Boyce, Sean Hanna or someone else who does not sue innocent homeowners after he breaks into their house.

7) There will be a new political calendar this year. The Primary could be as early as June or it could be in August. This would accelerate the petition passing date.

Our 33 member Executive Committee is operating as an effective political unit. However, with new people we can spread the work load around.
